Blåvand Bird Observatory wants ringer assistant

Since 1984, Blåvand Bird Observatory has ringed birds every spring and autumn on the whole and through the years, we've ringed more than 200.000 birds of many different species.

As a support for our ringer, we need an assistant for the spring and autumn of 2017. The ringing seasons are from March 1st to June 15th and from July 20th to November 15th. We use 242 meters of net, and from the beginning of autumn, we hope to be able to catch birds in a newly made Helgoland trap.

You will help free birds from the net. Also, the birds must be measured biometrically. In order to be considered for the position, you must be able to determine the birds, and if you have previous experience with ringing, and possibly a license, it will be an advantage.

Unfortunately, we are not able to offer payment, but we can offer you to live at the bird observatory without costs, where you will find all daily necessities such as bath, washing machine, wi-fi and all kitchen facilities. You must supply your own groceries.

If you are interested, and able to participate, you can write to blaavandfuglestation@gmail.com. The minimum time period for a stay is 14 days, and people who are able to stay for longer periods of time will be preferred.
